## PUNTA ALLEN

Punta Allen is a typical quiet lobster fisherman village in the heart of the "Sian ka'an Biosphere" about 100 miles south of Cancun.

Driving south from the growing city of Tulum following the highway signs to Boca Paila and Punta Allen, you will travel approximately 32 miles through the jungle on a ocean front gravel and sand road. Punta Allen is at the end of the road.



In Punta Allen you can find small food markets, souvenirs, small typical restaurants, telephone, internet cafe, first aid clinic and police office.



### THE POSADA

Our Posada was build with the goal to give you a touch of Mediterranean stile and maximum comfort to let you feel at home.



### The rooms

Our 'posada' has 4 comfortable rooms with private bathroom and hot water showers.



Towels and bed linen are changed every 2 days. 2 rooms have 3 single beds and 2 room have 2 single beds. The single beds can be joined to make a king size bed or remain as individuals



Upstairs in our "terrace" you will find a bar/lounge where you can kick back after a hard day of fishing. Relax with a Mexican beer or Pina Colada while you swap story with your friends about the day's fishing experience and tales of the "big catch" or the one "that got away".



The restaurant, exclusivity for our guest, is where you can enjoy some of the specialties of the region. Daily fresh fish or lobster, regional meats, fruits or vegetables or a touch of Italian and French cuisine will be yours to taste.

Non-fisherman may opt to take a daily excursion of just relax on the local beach or some other secluded spot to soak up the sun. Don't forget your sun tan protection and sunglasses because the sun is very strong. Usually mosquitoes are out at dawn and sunset for about one hour, then they seem to disappear, but proper protection is required to avoid bites.

Bones, permit, tarpon & snook in a single day can be yours.

### Bonefish:

This fast energetic runner is abundant in the entire area with a range of fish from 2 to 6 pound, but 8 or 10 pounder are caught often in the deeper flats.



### Permit:

Ascension Bay is one of the best spot on the planet to target this unbelievable fish. Permit is an all year resident even though some month are better than others. Prime time runs from February to may, but December - June can also be excellent. Permit is a patrolling fish and can be found in both deeper and shallow open flats and in the inside lagoons.



### Tarpon:

Also this fish is an all year resident but they move from place to place depending on the tide and current. Sometimes they will rise near the village's wharf, and sometimes you may need to search all around the lagoon. Range is from 6 to 30 pound but some big fish over 60/70 pound are caught each year.



### Snook:

Year round resident this fish is abundant in all the place close to submerged trees and the mangrove. This fish are from 2 to 8 pound but 10 to 20 pounder are not uncommon.



### Cuda, jack, snapper, bluefish, & co.

A lots of other sport fish inhabits the bottom all around the Ascension Bay and the open sea. Fly fishing, trolling, spinning or vertical jigging are productive. April and may are the best for marlin, sailfish and wahoo on trolling but also on fly fishing. In vertical jigging fish over 40 pound are the usual target.
